

Privacy Statement of Gameye B.V.

18 February 2019

In order to provide our services, we, Gameye, will process personal data through our Gameye API and our website (www.gameye.com). We consider the careful handling of personal data of the utmost importance. For this reason, we observe due care in the processing and protection of personal data.

During the processing of personal data, Gameye adheres to the requirements of the applicable data protection legislation, like the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). This means we:

- **clearly specify our purposes** before we process personal data, by using this privacy statement;
- **limit our collection of personal data** to only the personal data needed for legitimate purposes;
- first **ask for explicit permission** to process personal data in cases where permission is required;
- take **appropriate security measures** to protect personal data and we demand the same from parties who process personal data on our behalf;
- **respect** your right to access, correct or delete your personal data held by us.

In this privacy statement, we will explain what kind of personal data we collect and for which purposes. We recommend that you read it carefully.

Website Gameye

Registration

Certain features of our service require you to register beforehand. You will have to provide some information about yourself and choose a username and password for the account that we will set up for you.

For this purpose, we use the company name, contact person, address details, phone number, email address and credit card information. This processing is necessary for the performance of the agreement you have with us. We store this information until your account is closed.

We will retain this data so that you do not have to re-enter it every time you visit our website, and in order to contact you in connection with the execution of the agreement, invoicing and payment.

Cookies

Our website makes use of cookies. Cookies are small files in which we can store information, so that you do not have to fill in that information again. We can also use them to see whether you are visiting us again.

The first time you visit our website, we will show you a notification explaining our cookies and ask for your permission for the use of these cookies. You can disable the use of cookies through your browser setting, but some parts of our website may not work properly as a result of that.

Through our website and as part of the Google Analytics, cookies of the company Google are placed. We use these services, amongst others, to get reports about how visitors use the website, the use of advertisements and the use of Google's search engine.

If required by law, or where such third parties process the information on Google's behalf, Google may transfer this information to third parties. We have no influence over the processing of personal data by Google. Please read the privacy statement of Google to read what they do with your (personal) data via these cookies.

Gameye API

The Gameye API can be used to set up online multiplayer games on any e-sports platform or for dedicated server based multiplayer games for game studios. Processing personal data is necessary to run the Gameye API. For example, the IP-addresses of the players that play the multiplayer games will be processed. Processing live information such as events and player scores is another feature of the Gameye API. For example, nicknames of players will be processed along with statistics and scores of a specific match.

We share data with the following parties:

- **Google (Analytics)**

Providing data to third parties

Except for the parties mentioned above, we do not under any circumstance provide your personal data to other companies or organizations, unless we are required to do so by law (for example, when the police demands access to personal data in case of a suspected crime).

Security

We take security measures to reduce misuse of and unauthorized access to personal data. We take the following measures in particular:

- we use secure connections to encrypt all information between you and our website when entering your personal data;
- we keep logs of all requests for personal data;
- logical access control, by making use of passwords;
- securing network connections via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology;
- access to personal data is restricted to those persons who need the personal data for fulfilling their tasks.

Processing outside of the EU

In case personal data is transferred from the European Economic Area to a service provider for processing in any country outside the European Economic Area that is not recognized by the EU Commission, as providing an adequate level of protection for personal data, we provide for appropriate safeguards as foreseen under the applicable data protection law.

Changes to this privacy statement

We reserve the right to modify this privacy statement. We recommend that you consult this statement on a regular basis, so that you remain informed of any changes.

Inspection and modification of your data

You can always contact us if you have any questions about our policy in regard to the processing of your personal data.

You have the following rights:

- Right of access: you have the right to see what kind of personal data we process.
- Right of rectification: you have the right to rectify any personal data we process, if this information is (partially) wrong.
- Right to complain: you have the right to file a complaint against the processing of your personal data by us, or against direct marketing.
- Right to be forgotten: you can file a request with us to remove any personal data we processed of you.

- Right to data portability: if technically possible, you have the right to ask us to transfer your processed personal data to a third party.
- Right to restriction of processing: you can file a request with us to (temporarily) restrict the processing of your personal data.

If you exercise any of the rights mentioned above, we will ask to identify yourself with a valid ID, to verify it is your personal data. It is important that you make sure that our social security number and photo are not visible.

We will usually comply to your request within 30 days. This term can be extended if the request is proven to be complex or tied to a specific right. You will be notified about a possible extension of this term.

Complaints

If the assistance we are offering is not to your satisfaction, you have the right to file a complaint with the competent authority. For the Netherlands, this is the Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens (<https://autoriteitpersoonsgegevens.nl/nl/zelf-doen/privacyrechten/klacht-indienen-bij-de-ap>).
